ARD Awards Contract for Auburn Bike Park; Construction Start Date Anticipated in July

Auburn, CA — The Auburn Area Recreation and Park District (ARD) awarded a contract to Frank Loduca Co. for the construction of Phase I of the Auburn Bike Park.

This recreational facility will be constructed on land owned by the Bureau of Reclamation and managed by ARD. Phase I will take in all design features above (west of) the Shirland Canal along Maidu Drive just east of the City of Auburn. Features incorporated in Phase I include the pump track, strider track, skills trails, parking and ADA compliant viewing area.

“We are so very excited to get work started on this project” remarked Kahl Muscott, ARD District Administrator. “There has been an outpouring of support, both physical and monetary, from the community. There is so much enthusiasm from the kids and their parents”

Development of Phase I of the Auburn Bike Park is expected to begin in early to mid-July and should finish by late summer.

The Auburn Area Recreation and Park District is a California Special District formed in 1948, providing recreation and park services to approximately 48,000 Auburn-area residents.
