

2017 Counselor-in-Training Program

- Counselors-in-Training must have completed 7th or 8th grade. The CIT program has a limited number of openings available.
- CITs must include the questionnaire and a written recommendation by a teacher with the registration packet. If there is a question of suitability, the Youth Services Manager will contact the parent.
- CITs must be willing to assist at day camp in a variety of ways such as snack preparation, set up for events, assisting program leaders in the younger groups, art and sports activities, and walking campers to locations. CITs are not placed with the Pathfinders, Trailblazers or Rangers groups. CITs are expected to remain in their assigned duties until directed by a staff person.
- CITs must be cooperative, display a respectful attitude to all campers & staff and follow camp rules. CITs may not use or carry cell phones until signed out for the day, and may not take photos or video of campers, staff or of the public, or access the internet. They may not share social media contacts with campers or staff.
- Any medications must be turned in to the director upon arrival in the original container and accompanied by a Parent Consent for Administration of Medications and Medical Chart indicated dosage and times.
- CITs who stay in the afternoon will choose between swimming (if scheduled) or helping in the non-swim activities.
- CITs may only leave the grounds if signed out by a parent or other approved adult, or if we have permission (below) allowing the CIT to sign out personally.
- CITs who do not abide by camp rules, show a negative attitude or disrupt the flow of camp will not be allowed to remain in the CIT program.
