ARD Board of Directors Special Meeting July 31, 2025

The Issue

Shall the Auburn Recreation District Board of Directors authorize and approve Resolution #2025-22, a resolution awarding a contract for the ARD Recreation Park Gym Roof Replacement Project to PnP Construction Inc?

Background

The ARD Recreation Park gym roof failure was discovered in October 2024 and emergency shoring/bracing was installed in the interior of the gym in November 2024. Working with the ARD insurance team, an engineer was selected to prepare construction drawings for the replacement project in March 2025. Project was put out to bid in June 2025. Eighteen companies (nine General Contractors, nine subcontractors) attended the mandatory pre-bid meeting on 7/8/25. Six bids were received and opened on 7/29/25. PnP Construction Inc. submitted the lowest bid in the amount of \$659,774.00.

Recommendation for the Board of Directors

Staff recommends that the Board of Directors authorize and approve Resolution #2025-22 awarding the low bid of \$659,774.00 to PnP Construction Inc.

Fiscal Impact

Fiscal impact of the approval of the contract with PnP Construction Inc. is \$659,774.00 plus a 5% District controlled contingency of \$32,988.70 for a total of \$692,762.70. These funds will be reimbursed to the District by the insurance provider.

- **6. DEMOLITION/LEAD PAINT REMOVAL:** Roof overhang beige paint contains lead and is described in the 11/20/24 Testing Report by NORCAL Environmental Mgmt. Inc. This report (and asbestos report showing none) are already part of the bid documents. The roof overhangs and any adjacent loose/flaky lead paint shall be cut off, bagged, removed, and properly disposed as one of

the early items of work. Contractor shall provide a copy of the Disposal Manifest to the owner/district.

- 7. PAINTING: Interior and exterior walls (excluding custom mural on north exterior wall) that tie into the new roof system plus all new exterior overhangs fascia, trim, rafter tails and gutters shall be painted. Colors to match existing.
- **8. SERVICE/WARRANTY AGREEMENT ON EXSITING SOLAR SYSTEM:** There is no such agreement present that will conflict with contractor removing and replacing the existing system.
- 9. FENCED CONSTRUCTION MOBILIZATION/LAYDOWN AREA: The district will work with the awarded contractor to provide as much area in the upper parking lot as possible for contractor use including space for stockpiling shoring lumber and solar equipment/gym light storage.
- 10. "EXCESS" INSURANCE POLICIES/LIABILITY LIMIT REQS: Excess insurance policies are acceptable towards the \$2mil occurrence coverage requirement.
- 11. PARKING LOT/PAVEMENT PROTECTION: In addition to the provisions contained in the protections Coordination Note on the drawings cover sheet, the contractor shall provide means necessary to protect all paving surfaces from damage by cranes or other equipment.
- 12. COMMUNITY CENTER EMPLOYEE & RECREATION PROGRAM ACTIVITIES: The district would like to maintain existing employee and recreation program activities in place to the greatest extent possible but will work with the awarded contractor on this issue to help ensure safety.
- 13. RE-MOUNTING EXSTING GYM LIGHTS: Contractor shall make provisions in their bid to re-mount the existing gym lights in a fixed position onto the new gym trusses after removal and storage. Awarded contractor to provide shop drawing of proposed method.



Where provisions of the following supplementary data differ from those of the original, this addendum shall govern and take precedence.

Bidders are hereby notified that they shall note receipt of this and all addenda in their proposals and make any necessary adjustments in their bids as a result of this and all addenda. It shall be construed that each bidder's proposal is submitted with full knowledge of all modifications and supplemental data specified herein.


The bid documents are modified/clarified as follows:


- 1. SOLAR PANEL WORK-NO PERMIT: There is no separate permit required to remove and re-install the existing solar panels.
- 2. SOLAR PANEL WORK-NO RAPID SHUTDOWN: There is no rapid shutdown device required when the existing panels are re-installed. The panels were originally permitted and installed prior to this being a code requirement. Regarding the existing solar panel rail attachments, since there is no way to know how many of these will be damaged and need replacing, this will need to be determined during construction and covered by change order.
- **3. ROOFING SURFACE/TYPE:** Roof surfacing shall be laminated composite shingles. Color TBD during submittals process. There is no ice shield required four feet up from the gutters.
- **4. UPDATED DRAWING SET:** Please refer to attached updated drawing set "Permit/RFI Response Set 7-21-25" as the new, current drawing set.
- 5. MISC RFI QUESTIONS/ANSWERS: Please see Pre-Bid RFI Questions and answers below:
 - 1. The roof connection to the existing CMU block at both of the gable ends (walls where the attic entry door is and the new fans go) is unclear. Can the engineer provide a cross section or detail here? Linchpin The connection at the gable ends is per detail 03/S-400. Please provide additional information regarding the unclear nature so I can address the concerns. The intent is for the gable ends to be constructed similar to the existing conditions. (Please see attached site visit photo below)





- 2. Scope of work says the project included insulation. What type of insulation is to be used and where is it to be located? Answered by Aaron wth Sugarpine on 7/15 SEE REVISED DRAWING SET
- 3. Detail 9 on S-400 shows new trusses welded to new ½" steel plate. Please provide plate/CMU anchorage detail. Linchpin The existing conditions show a bearing plate at the pilasters. However, the condition of the plate and anchorage could not be determined. Therefore, the new bearing plate detail was added to be handle the condition if the bearing plate must be replaced. It is preferable from a constructability and cost aspect to utilize the existing bearing plate. If possible, once the roof and framing are demo-ed, coordinate with the Linchpin regarding the existing bearing plate and anchorage to determine adequacy. For the purpose of bidding assume a pl 1/2x6"x 14" wide bearing plate with (2) ¾" diameter post installed threaded rod with epoxy.





- 4. Detail 4 on S-400 states, "CONTINUOUS EDGE NAILING (CEN) WHERE REQUIRED PER PLAN. SEE DETAIL B AT BLOCKED DIAPHRAGM" Detail B shows 3 x 4 panel edge blocking. The roof plan on sheet S-201 does not reference detail 4 on S-400. Is panel edge blocking required at all panel edges? Linchpin yes panel edge blocking is required at all panel edges.
- 5. Detail 3 on S400 calls for a "CMST12 X 7'-0" w/ 16d ALL HOLES STRAP AT EACH 4x BREAK." It appears that the new CMST12 strap is centered over the new trusses at the truss/purlin connection. What 4x is the note referring to? Please note that the center-to-center nail hole dimension on the CMST12 is 1-1/2", and the specified purlins are 1-3/4" wide. It would be extremely difficult, if not impossible to install the specified CMST12 strap with two 16d nails in the 1-3/4" wide LVL purlin. Please clarify.
- 6. With the above, is Detail 3 on S400 typical at all truss/purlin connections? Or, is it only at Lines 2 & 6? Linchpin yes at every rafter break.
- 7. Detail 3 on S-400 references a "subfascia". Is it the intent of the design drawings to have a secondary main fascia installed over the "subfascia"? If so, please provide a size and species of wood to be used for the main fascia. Linchpin a secondary fascia is not required
- 8. The plans show a 200 AMP panel but the (E) panel has undersized feeder wire and the sweep into panel would need to be upsized to 2 inches. Sugarpine: Plans note: CONTRACTOR SHALL TRACE FEEDER TO UPSTREAM DISTRIBUTION SOURCE, AND IDENTIFY FEEDER OVERCURRENT PROTECTION DEVICE AND PANEL DESIGNATION. MEASURE FEEDER GAUGE. PROVIDE AND INSTALL A (N) KEY-LOCKABLE, 30-POSITION, NEMA I, MAIN CIRCUIT BREAKER PANELBOARD WITH AMPACITY NO LESS THAN THE UPSTREAM OVERCURRENT PROTECTION DEVICE AMPERE RATING.
 - Per the plans, the contractor needs to check the breaker rating and wiring size relative to that, then provide a panel that is rated at least the same or higher than the breaker. The intent is to replace the panel only and not to upsize the breaker nor the feeder. The feeder and raceway should only be upsized if the existing wire gauge is undersized for the existing circuit breaker.
- 9. Verify type of insulation and whether or not skyrim will be used. Need details on plans. See Mechanical plans for insulation requirements.
- 10. Gable end ventilation fans show details on plans. Note does the full-height CMU block wall at the gable end get cut to allow for the whole house fan installation? Need more detail or clarification. Linchpin vents shall utilize existing CMU wall opening. New openings not required.
- 11. Gable end cross section and details showing connections how outriggers for overhang and truss along gable will look. Will the trusses at each gable end be removed? Please revise plans and clarify. Linchpin See updated S-400
- Need more Bearing plate detail at pilaster PL1/2x6. Connection? Linchpin See response to RFI above
