The Auburn Pickleball Club remains committed to our mission of being pickleball ambassadors for the greater Auburn area—and we are proud to report strong momentum.

Membership & Visibility

October 2026 will mark the 3rd year of APC. Our club currently has 146 members. Our website receives new visitors each month, indicating strong community engagement and ongoing curiosity about this fast-growing sport.

Community Engagement & Tournament Play

The Heroes Pickleball Tournament was a great success thanks to the staff at ARD. Due to rainy weather, we moved the tournament inside the Regional Gym. We went from 6 courts to 3 courts. ARD staff (Manouch, Scott & Randy) made sure we had access to everything we needed and moved bleachers and tables for us. Stand Up Placer CEO gave eye-opening statistics about sexual assault, domestic violence, and human trafficking in Placer County. Tournament players included Auburn Fire, Cal Fire, Cal State Park Rangers, Sac County Probation, Nevada County Sheriffs, and local community members. Our sponsors included A-Town Bikes & Pickleball, Auburn Total Health, Burn Boot Camp, DAR, Incredible Pets, Merrill Powers, Mike & Patsy Lynch, Never Better Coffee, and Sandra Strautman. We also had raffle prizes from Awful Annies, Burn Boot Camp, John Carter, Ginger Barrett, Green Acres, Placer County Sheriff, Ikedas, Old Town Pizza, and APC. The Summer Slam Tournament is coming up.

Indoor Play & Lessons

Jr. Pickleball Camp is available for ages 7-15 this summer. Tracy Houk will be teaching a fun, fast-paced introduction to pickleball.

I want to give a shout-out to Andie for her help. She encourages people to sign up for a membership of \$100 rather than pay \$60 for 20 wristbands. She also walks hesitant people over to the gym to meet us. All indoor play is scheduled on the PlayTime Scheduler app. You must be a member of the club or purchase a wristband to play indoors.

The Fun Committee

A huge shoutout to our Fun Committee, led by Kim and Amy, who have created a welcoming and upbeat atmosphere that encourages community participation. All events are posted on the Playtime scheduler and are open to the public, with at least one court always reserved for drop-in play. Highlights include:

Women's Ladder – Tuesdays (Spring and Fall)

Mixed Ladder – Wednesdays (Spring and Fall)

The Welcome Committee provides free lessons and helps integrate brand-new players into the local pickleball community. Flyers have been posted at Regional Park, School Park Preserve, and Meadow Vista. Our weekly emails provide information for lessons with a pro.
